

GRUMO MUSIC FESTIVAL
STUDENT ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT

This contract sets forth the terms and conditions between Grumo Festival, Inc ("Grumo Festival") and _____ ("Student") for the festival and associated classes scheduled from July 2, 2012 to July 7, 2012 in Grumo Appula and Binetto, Italy ("festival").

1. Application. The Grumo Festival reserves the right to accept or reject applications from students at its own sole discretion, based on, but not limited to, the materials submitted and festival space availability. In the case of non-acceptance, tuition and other payments (pictures, extra lesson) will be immediately refunded. Students will be notified of their acceptance within two weeks from receipt of this application.
2. Minors. Students who are minors must have this Agreement signed by their parents or legal guardians. Grumo Festival is not responsible for nor does it have the ability or the means to take care of students under the age of 18 during any phase of the festival. Additionally, due to Grumo Appula city regulations, no student under the age of 18 is allowed on the stage in the main square, a setting for one of the possible evening concerts, without parental consent.
3. Tuition. Tuition is \$549. Discounted tuition is as follows: \$399 if full payment is received by December 20, 2011; \$454 if full payment is received by February 1, 2012. Returning students may receive a discount on their tuition. Returning students' tuition is set at \$399. Tuition may be paid, by personal check, bank certified check, or money order, to Grumo Festival Inc., PO BOX 7355, Grand Rapids, MI 49510-7355. Tuition includes three (3) individual applied instrument lessons, plus all lectures, presentations, master classes, and concerts held during the festival. Tuition also includes participation in all social events and gatherings organized by Grumo Festival during the festival. Tuition DOES NOT include meals, travel, or room and board.
4. Extra Applied Lesson In addition to the three (3) individual lessons covered by Tuition, students can choose to receive one extra lesson. The cost is \$45. Discounted extra lesson is as follows: \$35 if full payment is received by December 20, 2011; \$40 if full payment is received by February 1, 2012.

5. Pictures Every year all Grumo Festival activities are documented through official pictures, typically between 500 and 1000 photographs, taken by a hired photographer. Students wishing to receive these pictures in electronic format may elect to do so only at the time of their application. Pictures include one entire set of high-definition photographs on a memory card, and a license. Pictures are sold for \$199. Discounted pictures are offered as follows: \$159 if full payment is received by December 20, 2011; \$179 if full payment is received by February 1, 2012. Please, indicate your preference:

6. Refunds. Tuition, Extra Applied Lesson, and Pictures are non-refundable except as follows: Tuition, Extra Applied Lesson, and Pictures will be refunded only in the event an entire course is canceled (for whatever reason) or not activated by Grumo Festival.

Grumo Festival is not responsible or liable for any other costs or damages that result from the cancellation or for not activating a course. Students who have paid all or part of their tuition but who cannot attend the Grumo Festival for which the Tuition was paid, and who cancel their appearance in writing at least 10 days in advance of the festival, will receive a credit in the same amount for the next Grumo Festival and be immediately placed on the family hosting waiting list for such future festival. In the event the student cannot attend the next such festival the tuition shall be forfeited.

7. Instruction time included in tuition. Each student will receive three (3) applied lessons of 60 minutes each. In addition students will attend all lectures, presentations, master classes, rehearsals, and concerts offered. At least one studio class will also be part of the program. Practice time and space will be available to all students. A detailed schedule of lessons, lectures, master classes, concerts, and other events will be finalized in the weeks approaching the festival.
8. Performance time included in tuition. All students are expected to perform in the final student concert. In addition all students are encouraged to perform in all other concerts organized by the festival. A flexible and possibly memorized repertoire ranging from approx. 5 to approx. 20 minutes would be sufficient for such performances.
9. Change in Schedule. Because Grumo Festival relies upon volunteers for many of the festival related activities, it reserves the right to cancel a course or concert or to rearrange scheduled events including classes or concerts as may become necessary due to volunteer unavailability or other scheduling issues.
10. License and Copyright. Student grants to Grumo Festival an irrevocable, lifetime license to record, photograph, film or otherwise capture and use for such purposes as Grumo Festival so desires all appearances, performances, lectures and any other activities associated with the festival without royalty or fee.
11. Room and Board/Social Events. Grumo Festival will strive to provide free room and board to Students with local hosting families. Room and board cannot, however, be guaranteed, as hosting families offer room and board at will or out of generosity, and no written agreement or other contract exists between Grumo Festival and these families. Students who have been accepted for the festival and who have paid their Tuition in full will be placed with hosting families based on two general criteria: 1) on a first come first-served basis; 2) based on specific requests from families (i.e. if a family asks for a female student, Grumo Festival will have no choice but to place the first female student on its waiting list, etc.) For special circumstances, Grumo Festival reserves the right to place students with local families regardless of the above criteria. Grumo Festival is not responsible for anything related to any accommodations, including but not limited to damages, accidents or the last-minute inability of a hosting family to offer the expected room and board. Students who wish to lodge elsewhere are entirely responsible for all the costs associated with their room and board. When room and board is provided, it commences on July 2, 2012 and ends on July 7, 2012. Please indicate your lodging preference below:

f. Room and Board arrangements will be confirmed by June 11, 2012.

g. Grumo Festival may organize social events for all participants, students and guests included (i.e. opening reception, an evening social gathering etc.) where food may be provided.

12. Travel. Students are responsible for their own travel arrangements and all associated costs. On the days of arrival and departure, Grumo Festival will provide them with a ride to and from the Bari Palese Airport, the Bari Centrale Railroad Station, and the Grumo Appula and Binetto railroad stations. Grumo Festival will also do its best to provide rides to students lodging with families or on their own in Grumo Appula, Binetto, and Bitetto, but cannot guarantee rides will be available.
13. Expenses. Student is responsible for his/her own expenses while at the festival. Grumo Festival will not reimburse any expenses.
14. Waiver of liability. Facilities, instruments, hosting families, stages, etc. are not the property of Grumo Festival, and Faculty and students are responsible for their own conduct and well-being during the festival and related activities. Grumo Festival will exercise reasonable care in connection with each of the activities it undertakes in connection with the festival. However, because there are many variables that are not within its control it assumes no liability for the safety of individuals or property and is not responsible or liable for any claims, accidents or events leading to personal injury, property damage, death, disability, loss of income or consequential or incidental damages of any nature or type arising from or relating to the festival, related activities, transportation or host family arrangements and related room and board. Student specifically waives any claim against Grumo Festival for personal injury or property damages of any nature or type sustained while attending or participating in the festival or related activities or associated with transportation or host family arrangements and related room and board.
15. Entire Agreement. This Agreement contains the entire understanding of the parties with respect to its subject matter. There are no additional promises, representations, or assurances between the parties other than those which are expressly written in this Agreement. This Agreement may not be amended except in writing signed by the parties.
16. Governing Law: This Agreement, and each of its terms, conditions and provisions, shall be governed by, and construed and enforced in accordance with, the laws of the State of Michigan
